Lewis son of Col. Robert Lewis six hundred acres of
Land I took ^{up} my self joining the Land I bought of
Mr. James Chapman to him & his heirs forever

I do give & bequeath unto my Grandson Robert Son
of ^{Col.} Robert Lewis four hundred acres of Land I
bought of James Lawley to him & his heirs forever

I do give & bequeath unto my Grandson Robert
Lewis son of Col. Robert Lewis six cows & calves
& six sons & pigs to him & his heirs forever

I do give & bequeath all the rest of my Estate to be
divided among my children

I do hereby bequeath all the rest of my Estate to be
Equally Divided between my Daughter Ann Levey
my son in law Col^l Robert Lewis & my grandson
Richard Meriwether son of my son William
Meriwether to them & their heirs Forever
Lastly I do constitute appoint & ordain Col^l
Robert Lewis Execut^r of this my last will &
Testament as witness my hand & seal this
2^d day of March 1753
