my Will and desire is that my exec^{rs} do sell in fee simple my Tract of Land on Ho-
ney Run in Hanover County to the best bidder, and my Will and Desire is
that the Money arising from such sale be Equally divided among my five son.
My^{rs} Tho^{rs} John, Isaac, Francis and Christopher. Item. All the real and Personal
my Estate Real and Personal, that is to say Lands, Mill, Negroes, Stock, &
Household Goods, Debts, Money and other Estate whatever I stand bound to
and devise to my Daughter Ursula Clark during her life, and after her
Death I give and devise the same to the Heirs of her Body lawfully begot-
ten forever, but in case that Ursula shall die without lawful Issue, my Will
is that all the Estate hereby Given her shall be sold by my exec^{rs} in fee simple

after shall at any time make any misuse or abuse any part of the
Estate hereby given to her that I will that if any such Person

Person she may marry shall immediately or on reasonable notice she
