Day of March 1763 in France being the County of Paris
Parish of St. Martin being very sick and weak in Body
of perfect mind & Memory thanks be given unto God This
calling unto mind the Mortality of my Body and knowing that
it was appointed for all men once to die, To make and ordain
My last Will and Testament that is to say principally
first of all I give & recommend my Soul into the Hands of
God that gave it and my Body I recommend to the Earth
to be buried in decent Christian Burial at the Discretion
My Executors Nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection
shall receive the same by the mighty Power of Je-
sus our Lord & Saviour Christ And as touching such an
Estate where with it hath pleased God to bless me
this Life I give demise and dispose of the same
in the following Manner and Form In witness where of

Will that all my Just debts be fully satisfied and
I do give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Gale
Robert Gale her Husband one Negro Boy named Ned
Negro Girl named Hannah which said Negroes are
Increase after the Death of ^{Mary} and Robert Gale, is to be
equally between the Heirs of their Bodies lawfully
begotten Item I do give and bequeath unto my Daughter ^{Mary}
one child of Martin Channice Negro Boy named
and once Negro Girl named Lucy during her life and after her
Decease to the Heirs of her Body lawfully begotten by
said Martin Channice Item I do give and bequeath
unto all the Heirs and assigns of my late and personal for
during her Natural life and after her Decease I give and
bequeath all that Tract of Land whereon I now live
and reside to him or his Heirs for ever and fully together
and if he should die without lawful heirs then his heirs
and assigns should have the same

that Robert, Sam is my will and Desire that after the Death of
my said wife my Estate not already mentioned be equally
divided amongst Children John, Harriett, Susan, and my
Succannah, as many of them as shall attain to the Age of
21 is my will and Desire that if any of my Son or should die
without Issue before they should arrive to the Age of 21 years
one Year then their Part should be equally divided among
my Surviving Son, Sam my Will & Desire that if the
last mentioned Daughters should die without Issue
before they arrive to the Age of 21 years one Year then their
Survivor should possess her part. Thus in my Will and
that my Negro Girl Sal who is a Natural Free Girl was
at the expense of my last mentioned Children John Harriett
Gedion Amos and Succannah Sam I do further by this my
last Will and Testament constitute Appraisers to value
my beloved Wife Ann Lea and my friend Thomas White
Johnston

of Antigua County to be taken in presence of
Will and Testament. His is my Will & I desire that my
Estate shall not be appraised nor sold nor divided
until my Decease revoke and disannul all and every the
former Testaments wills Legacies Bequests by me in
any Wills before named Will and bequeathed
and confirming thereof no other to be my last will and
Testament in Wills for whereof I have hereunto setting
Hand and Seal the Day and Date above written
