for and in Behalf of to the Sole Use & behoof of the
Justices of the P. County & their Successors, in the sum
of five Hundred Thousand Pounds to be paid to the
S. Thomas Johnson his Exors. Administrators or Assigns
to the which payment well & truly to be made

we bind ourselves & every of us, our, heirs, & our heirs
Executors & Administrators jointly & Severally, firmly by
these presents. Sealed With our Seals, Dated this
Eighth Day of October Anno Domini 1781

The Condition of this Obligation is Such, That if
The Above bound Susannah Annell David Annell &
James Annell Executors of the last Will & Testament of
James Annell Dec'd do make or cause to be made a
true & proper Inventory of all & singular the Goods
Chattels & Credits of the sd Dec'd which have or shall
come to the hands, Possession, or Knowledge of the sd
Susannah David & James or into the hands & Possession
of any other Person or Persons for them and the same
do make do exhibit unto the County Court of Louisa
as and when the Court shall order.

P Court & the same Goods Chattels & Credits & all other
 the Goods Chattels & Credits of the P Decd Which or
 any Time after shall come to the hands Possessor
 Knowledge of the S. Susannah, David & Annor into
 the hands & Possession of any Other Person or Persons
 for them do well & Truly administer According to law
 & further do make a true & Just Account of their
 doings & Doings thereon When there to be required by
 the P Court & also shall well & Truly pay & Deliver
 all the Legacies Contained & Specified in the P Testaments
 as far as the P Goods Chattels & Credits will thereunto
 extend & the Law shall Charge them this Obligation
 to be Void & of none effect or else to turn vain & full force
 & Virtue
