I Give devise & Dispose of the same in the following Manner

Imprimis I Give & bequeath to Richard Goodall & son
Charles Goodall after any wife's decease & Vigns My Married
Dick to him & his heirs

Item all the Rest of my Estate both Real and Personal
after my Just debts are paid I Give to my loving wife Eliza Goodall
to her & her heirs I appoint Executors together with

My father I give & bequeath to Abraham Goodall & my
Charles Goodall after my wife's decease in Vign. My beloved
Dick to him & his heirs

From all the Rest of my Estate both Real and Personal
after my Just debts are paid I Give to my Loving Wife Eliza Goodall
to her & her heirs whom I appoint Executrix together with
Capt Abraham Vernash & Daniel Williams whom I appoint
Executors of this my Last Will & Testament In Witness
Whereunto I set my hand & Seal this day and year first above
