Was my last Will and Testament in Manner following that is to say
In witness I give and bequeath unto my son John Cosby and his Heirs &
Assigns for ever the following Nineteen Slaves and their Increase to wit
Tom, Kate, young Kate, York, George, Dick, Phoebe, Sam, Aggy a child, Robin, Moll,
Dingo, Joe, Dinah, Scipio, Hone, Hannah, Lucy, & Phyllis, Item I give and
bequeath unto my son William Cosby and his Heirs & Assigns forever the
following twenty two Slaves and their Increase to wit, Old Will, Moll, Kate
Will, Old Dinah, Matt, Pops, ~~Sam~~, great Jimmy, young Dinah, little Peter,
young Tom, Adam, young Jimmy, Adam, Aggy a girl, little Jimmy, old
Charles, Jack, great Peter, Jolly, Bachel, Willy, Harri. Item I give and
bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Ingleton and her heirs & Assigns
for ever the following eight Slaves and their Increase to wit, Harriet,
Charles, Rodah, Pat, Let, Mary, Chelcia, and Patts Child as yet.

unnamed; I do give and bequeath unto my granddaughter
Mary Anderson Wife of Ben^d Anderson and her heirs and assigns
for ever the following two Slaves to wit, Ned, and Cnea, and the
Increase of the said Cnea. I do give and bequeath unto my
grandson James Duke Thishers Vajagno forever one Negro
Slave named Talby the Increase. I do give & bequeath unto
my grandson Cosby Duke Thishers Vajagno forever one Negro Slave
named Michael. I do give & bequeath unto my grandson James
Cosby son of James Cosby this Negro Vajagno forever one Negro Slave named
peg the Freeman. I do give, devise & bequeath unto my son for
Cosby and his heirs & assigns forever all my land in Hanover County
Virginia containing about seven Hundred & Eighty
acres more or less with the Appurtenances. I do give devise and
bequeath unto my son William Cosby Twelve Hundred Acres of
Land out of my Trade of Land in Lanja County where I live
and more or less.

Where he the said William now lives and where the Quarter is that is
called Wills Quarters which said twelve Hundred acres of Land with the
Appurtenances I devise to him my said son with body & heirs & assigns
for ever. Item the remainder of the above said Tract of three thousand
acres in the S^d County of Louisa after the S^d twelve hundred acres
laid off for my said son William as above mentioned the S^d remainder
being eighteen Hundred acres More or less I give Devise & bequeath unto
my Two Grandsons by Name Chas^r Dickerson and Higgason
Dickerson sons of Griffith Dickerson which with the Appurtenances
I Devise to them my S^d grandsons Charles Dickerson & Higgason to be
more to be Equally divided between them and their heirs & assigns for
ever. Item I give unto my said son John body all my personal
estate that lies & is being in the S^d County of Hanover. Item
I give unto my S^d son William body all my personal Estate
that lies and is being in the S^d County of Louisa. Item I give

that was and is being in the County of Louisa. I have given
unto my daughter Eliz^a Simpson One Negro girl name Betty
and her Indian son and her New Sashings for ever
lastly I constitute and appoint ^{for & of} My Two Friends Oliver
Duke and Bartholomew Anderson Executors of this my last Will
and Testament hereby revoking & making void all other Wills
Testaments heretofore by me made & confirming this & none
other to be my only last will & Testament In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my Hand & seal this Twelfth day of
September in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven
hundred & eighty
