of Land Beginning on the Branch below the house the now
lives in Wanning Pa Cross from Garths turn to turn the stone
taking up the horse run creek On both sides the said
 creek to include the hundred Acres to him & his heirs forever

I am Give to my Son in Law Stephen Hunter one hundred
& twenty five Acres of Land which has been laid off to him
already out of the run Survey to him & his heirs forever

I am Give to my Grand son William Dabney Natham

One Negro Boy Name Jack until he comes to Lawful
Age & after he comes to a Lawful age I give the said William

Dabney Natham the said Negro Boy Jack as his right &
property forever in case he dies before he is of age or marries

When Give the said Negro Boy to my Grand son Cornelius

Now I like to my Daughter Sarah Thackeray one

Natural life & at her Death. I then give the said Negro Wench
& her increase to such of my said Daughters Children as shall be
Living at her Death & then I then thus & never
Now it is my Will & I desire that all my Estate (except) the
said Negro Boy Jack that I give to my Grandson William
Dabney Thackeray both real & Personal & what kind some
be at the Death of my said Wife Equally Divided Among
such of my Children & their Representatives as I now mention
(Viz) Elizabeth Hardwick John Thackeray Ann Eastham
& my Daughter Jane Haly. I only give to her her Equall
Proportion of my Personal Estate as I have before Willed
but what I think is her proportion of my Land & at

to my Daughter Sarah I only give to her An Equal
part of my lands & my other Estate except the Negroes
as I have given to her & her heirs her full proportion of
them to my son Charles Natham to the Children of
my Dearest Daughter Mary Hunter & to the Child
of my Dearest Daughter, Mido Geo Humphrey by name
Martha Humphrey to them & their heirs forever

And it is my Will & Request that my sons John & Charles
Natham as Executors & my beloved Wife Martha ^{am} Nath
execute to this my last Will & Testament in Witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this fourteenth Day
September in the first one thousand Seven hundred
Eighty one

Open Court by Martha Latham the Executrix thereof
Named who took the Oath of an Executrix and entered into
Bond according to Law and was proved by the Oath
of John Garth, David Shepherd and Elizabeth Garth
the Witnesses thereto & by the Court Ordered to be Recorded
and the Court sits for the 2^d County the 16th Day of
Decem^r 1781 John Latham and Charles Latham
the other Executors to this Will came into Court and
took the Oath of Executors and entered into Bond as well
