of Jesus Christ he will receive it to his glory and I give
my body to the Earth from whence it was taken in full
hope and Assurance of the resurrection of the Body at
the last day when the Earth shall give up its Dead.
As to my worldly Estate and possessions which it hath
pleased Almighty God to give me, my will and desire is
that first of all I am first to be buried by my Executors
hereafter named, I then I give and bequeath to my
loving wife my whole Estate Both Land and personal
Else I dispose During her time of the same to be
after paying my debts and Funeral Charges and my
Will and desire is that after the death or death of my wife
my land on which I now dwell being the same

And to be sold in the highest Bitter as also my other goods
and chattels of what kind soever and the same to be divided
equally between the women hereafter coming by such means
equally divided among my four children as follows
Rebekah Henfor Richard Henfor Mary Thaxter
John Williams and Lastly I Consistently
Sarah Henfor my son 25 and Cyprian
Allen Executor of this my last will and testament
herby making full and valid all as my said will by me
made in absence for a trip out of State as well as
my hand and affix of mine at this place to wit near
near of our Lord Christ 1778
