As for such worldly Goods as God hath been pleased to bless me with, after all my Lawfull and Just debts are paid, I Will and dispose of the Remainder in the following manner, that is to say, I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary West all that corner of Land above Peter Mullins Branch where my 1st Daughter Mary now lives, containing Two Acres with or some more or less, I likewise give and bequeath unto my 1st Daughter Mary one Negro Boy named Jupiter the whole to her and her heirs forever, I then give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Temham one dark Bay Horse known by the name of the same Horse and which is now in the Possession of my 1st Daughter Elizabeth; also I give and bequeath unto my 1st Daughter Elizabeth her first choice of a Feather Bed and Furniture, out of all my household Furniture, Also I give and bequeath unto my 1st Daughter Elizabeth one Negro Woman slave named Lucy and all her Increase the whole to her my 1st Daughter Elizabeth and her heirs forever, I then give and bequeath to my Daughter Rebekah Washer one Negro Boy named Charles to her and her heirs forever, I then give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah Johnson one Negro Boy slave named Sam to her & her heirs forever, I then give and bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Temham one dark Bay Horse known by the name of the same Horse and now

One Mary one Negro Boy named Jupiter the whole to her and her
Heirs forever. I then give and bequeath unto my Daughter Eliza
one dark Gray Horse known by the name of the same Horse and which is
now in the Possession of my s^d Daughter Eliza, also I give and bequeath unto my
s^d Daughter Eliza her first Choice of a Feather Bed and Furniture, out of all
my Household Furniture, also I give and bequeath unto my s^d Daughter
Eliza one Negro Woman slave named Lucy and all her ^{future} Increase the
whole to her my s^d Daughter Eliza and her Heirs forever. I then
bequeath to my Daughter Rebekah Walker one Negro Boy named
Charles to her and her Heirs forever. I then give and bequeath unto my
Daughter Sarah Johnson one Negro Boy slave named Sam to her &
her Heirs forever. I then give and bequeath unto my Daughter Ann
Simmons one dark Brown Horse known by the name of John Horse and now
in the Possession of my s^d Daughter Ann, also I give and bequeath
unto my s^d Daughter Ann her first Choice of a Feather Bed
and Furniture out of all my Household Furniture, also I give and
bequeath unto my s^d Daughter Ann one Negro Man slave named
Tom the whole to her my s^d Daughter Ann and her Heirs forever. I then
my Will is that all the Remainder of my Estate both real and Per-
sonal, not already bequeathed as aforesaid, at my Decease shall be sold
by my Executors hereafter named and one Year Credit given to the best
Wholesale or Purchaser. Whatever by them to be sold is the Remainder
of my Estate and all my Household Furniture and in a word all my
Estate and what I bequeathed and the Money arising from the
Sale shall by my Will be disposed in the last Part of the foregoing

of my last Will (and the surplus if any there be) shall be Equally divided
among my five Daughters above mentioned. Lastly I approved my trusty
Friend Major John Barnwell of Johnson County and Thomas Johnson
son of Nicholas Johnson of Louisa County Va. and his Executors of this
my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me
made and Publishing this only as my last Will and Testament In Wit-
ness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Affixed my Seal this Twen-
ty third Day of December Anno Domini One Thousand seven Hundred
Twenty Eight
