I give and bequeath unto my son Rodas Gannon the Land
I purchased of John Odrington from the Lower South Corner of Robert
Hart's lot unto the fork of Robinson's Creek all that is above a line
named Sue a Bed and furniture for a Cow a calf to him & his heirs forever.

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Wigglesworth
one Negro boy named Dick a Girl named Jane the basin of possession
to her and her heirs forever. I give and bequeath unto my son

William Thomson half the Land back of the New Design fence one Negro
named Polly a Mare and Colt and Saddle that he has now in

possession, a Cow and Calf and a Bed and furniture to him and his
heirs forever. I give and bequeath unto my son Clifton Thomson

the other half of the Land back of the New Design fence to be Divided Between
them as they can best agree, one Negro Man named Jeffery a young boy

named two years old, my Riding Saddle, one Bed and furniture,
and a Cow and calf, to him and his heirs forever. I give

and bequeath unto my son Ira Thomson a Tract of Land
Beginning at the fork between here and John Odrington's and the

running thence a straight line to where my fence line crosses the
road from me down the Road to my lower corner on Joseph Thomson's

line, thence along his line to W. Diggers line thence along Diggers
line crossing the divide Diggers Mill Pond thence up the Pond
corner of the New Design fence, thence along the fence straight to the
upper line, thence to the beginning also one Negro Man named
Frank, a middling good Beast and Saddle a Bed and furniture
a middling good gun and a Cow and calf to him and his forever
them I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Ann the Third
Pound land thence also a Negro Man named Sam a middling
Beast and Saddle, a middling good gun, a Bed and furniture, a Cow and calf
and a good horse to her. I will this give and bequeath unto my
and bequeath unto my Daughter Anne the second one Negro boy
named Anthony, a Negro named Pegg, a middling good Beast and
Saddle, a Bed and furniture, and a Cow and calf and half piers
Scholar, to her and her heirs forever. I will this give and bequeath
unto my Daughter Elizabeth the third one Negro boy named Sam
one Negro girl named Phillis, a middling good Beast and Saddle
a Bed and furniture, a Cow and calf and two good horses
to her and her heirs forever. I will this give and bequeath unto
my Daughter Anne the fourth one Negro boy named John
one Negro girl named Phillis, a middling good Beast and Saddle

Also a Bed and furniture, a Cow and Calf and three years Schooling
to her and her heirs forever. I ~~Mr.~~ Give and bequeath unto
my son David Thomson the Reminder of my Land, (after
my wife Susan's death) ~~that he should have~~ whereon I now
live, Also a Negro boy named Isaac, a Riding good Beast
and Saddle, a Bed and furniture, Also a Riding good Gun,
a Cow and Calf and five years Schooling to him and his
heirs forever. I ~~Mr.~~ Give and bequeath unto my Daughter
Sarah Thomson a Negro boy named Moses, and a Girl named
Jane, a Riding good Beast and Saddle Also a Bed and
furniture, a Cow and Calf and three years Schooling to
her and her heirs forever. And in case either of my
children should die before they should come of age or marry,
then their part of my Estate I give to be Equally Divided
amongst all my Surviving children. I ~~Mr.~~ after all
my Debts are paid I give and bequeath all the Rest of
my Estate not so bequeathed to my dear wife and my
beloved Wife Anne Thomson her heirs forever.
I will appoint, constitute, and authorize

lastly I nominate, constitute, and do constitute
beloved Wife Anne Thomson as also Rodas Thomson and
William Thomson who are sole Ex^{rs} and Ad^{rs} of this my
Last Will and Testament, hereby expressing all that I wish
or Wills by me made before and during this to be
