In the name of God Amen I Agnes Williams of the County of
Lunenburg being in a low state of health but of perfect mind
and memory and knowing that it is appointed for all men to
die do recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God
who gave it and my body to be buried in a Christian like
manner and as touching my worldly Estate wherewith it has been
pleased God Almighty to bless me with I give and dispose of
in the manner and form following (Wiz)

Item It is my will and desire that all my just debts be paid by
my Executors. Item I give to my grand son William Williams

he bring a son of my son Nicholas Williams decd. One Negro Girl
named Stacey with her increase to him and his heirs forever, but if
the said William Williams should prefer to put the above named

negro with her increase in with my ^{other} Estate that the above named
William Williams shall have one seventh part of the whole of my

Estate to him and his heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath
the balance of my negroes to wit, Santee, Will, Eady, Sam and
Ranold together with my stock of all kinds, house hold and kitchen

furniture, also all my plantation tools of every description also
all my plantation ^{also} all my money that

all my plantation tools of every description also all my money that
I have due by bonds or in other way also all my crop that I have
by me or growing to my six daughters or their heirs whose names
are underneath (to wit): To Nancy Hardy and her heirs Lucy Walker
Swanna Lee, Martha Smithson and her heirs, Fudence Rappahock and
her heirs and Mary Gisdale to them & their heirs forever. Item It is
my will and desire that my negroes should not be sold if they can
be divided without. Item I constitute ordain and appoint William
Williams and Allen Walker Executors to this my last will and Testament
revoking all others that may have been heretofore made by me given
under my hand and seal this the twenty third day of September
in the year of our Lord Christ One thousand eight hundred and
twenty. Signed, sealed and delivered by }

In Lunenburg County Court the 16 day of October 1825 The within written
last will & Testament of Agnes Williams dec'd was presented in Court
and proved by the oath of two of the witnesses thereto subscribed and
ordered to be recorded and on the motion of William Williams one
Allen Walker the Executor named in the will who having made oath

him and attorney Lodole to them & their heirs forever. Item I do
my will and desire that my negroes should not be sold if they can
be divided without. Item I constitute ordain and appoint William
Williams and Allen Walker Executors to this my last will and testament
reversing all others that may have been heretofore made by me given
under my hand and seal this the twenty third day of September
in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and
twenty. Signed, sealed and delivered by }
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and proved by the oaths of two of the witnesses thereto subscribed and
ordered to be recorded and on the motion of William Williams and
Allen Walker the Executors therein named who having made oath
according to law certificate is granted them for obtaining probate of
said will in due form whereupon they gave bond with approved sureties
as the law directs for the law made. Attest
