Virginia do make my last Will and Testament in the following manner
that is to say 1st I leave to my beloved wife Nancy Tomlinson during her
life all my Estate both real personal and Personal if she has no
Child or Children by me but if she should have ~~children by me~~
will is that she have only one third during her life and the other two thirds
to go to my Child or Children if but one to go to that and he or she
than one to be equally divided between them or their heirs and the other
one third that my wife is to have during life to be equally divided between
my Children and their heirs if but one to that or that heirs at her death
If my wife should die without a Child or Children by me I leave
at her death all the property I have that I have received by my
wife or have a right to receive of the Estate of William Lee the
Elizabeth Lee daughter of said William Lee alone during her life
but if she should have an heir or heirs of her body to her & heirs
forever and also if she should die without an heir or heirs

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forever and also if she should die without an heir of her
body my will and desire is that the said property that I have received
by my life or have a right to receive from William Gees Estate be
equally divided between my Wifes Sisters or the heirs of them body or bodies

2nd If my wife should die without a child or children by me I leave
at her death all the property I possess or have a right to take real
personal and ^{personal and} ^{personal and} ^{personal and} the property I have received by
my wife have a right to receive of William Gees Estate to be equally
divided between my brothers & sisters to them & their heirs forever
and lastly I appoint my friends Lucas Geo & Reuben Gees
executors of this my ^{last} will and Testament revoking all other former

this 27th day of March 1818 the Words by my wife intended
to be herebefore signed

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And if my wife should die without a child or children by me I leave
at her death all the property I possess or have a title to both real
personal and divisible except the property I have received by
my wife have a right to receive of William Green estate to be equally
divided between my brothers sisters to them & their heirs forever
and lastly I appoint my friends Lucas Geo & Reuben Green
executors to this my ^{last} will and Testament revoking all other former
wills by me here before made.
