I Daniel Hazlewood Son of Lunsburg County and State of Vir-
ginia, do make my Last Will and Testament in the manner
and form following, that is to say I Give to my beloved wife Susanna
during her life on widowhood eighteen negroes, (which is to be worked by
her, for the benefit on the Land, that I shall see this Will bind
to her, and nowhere else, Bob arches, and Ruffin, George Hick, Davy
Haff, Ralph, Giles, Winfield, Amy Silvey, Faring, Beck, Nelt
Judah, and May together with all my household and kitchen
furniture, & stock of every kind, Cask and oven, and all my plan-
tation working tools, I also, bind to my wife during her life, a Widow
hood the upper part of my Land that is all the Land, that
I possess that lies above the line that is to be shown in the follow-
ing manner beginning at the mouth of my spring branch on one
corner then thence up the said Branch to a right hand spring thence
up said spring to the head, thence straight forward to my old
mill path and thence down S. Path to Bears Church Creek
and I also bind to my wife during her life

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her, for the benefit on the Land, that I shall see this will send
to her and nowhere else, Bob anchor, red Ruffin, George, Hail, Day,
Maz, Ralph, Giles, Winfield, Amy Selvy, Fanny, Beck, Will,
Judah, and Mary together with all my household and kitchen
furniture, & stock of every kind, Cows and oxen, and all my plan-
tation working tools, I also, send to my wife during her life, a Widow
hood the upper part of my Land. That is all the Land, that
I possess that her above her time that is to be made in the follow-
ing manner, beginning at the mouth of my spring, to run on one
corner of the said branch to a right hand spring then
up said spring to the head, then straight forward, to run old
mill path and then down to Path to Bears Clement Creek
and I also send to my wife during her life, the land, the
fields, now lying at the mouth of the said branch, the
Meham River and the other in Bears Clement Creek and
the my mill place and timber for years the Farmers
in said mill a house they want repairing, the Land

that I shall give to my son Daniel in his will 2nd I give and bequeath
to my son James Hazen all the property of mine he has now in
his possession and to him & his heirs forever 3^{rdly} I give & bequeath to my son
Daniel Hazen all the property of mine he has now in his
possession and to all the land I own except the land I
have lent to wife which he is not to have until my wife dies or
marries & at the death or marriage of said wife I also give that to
him and his heirs forever 4th I give and bequeath to my daughter Betsey
Andrews all the property of mine her husband Benjamin Andrews
has now in his possession to her & her heirs forever 5^{thly} I give and bequeath
to my daughter Lucy Freeman all the property of mine her husband
Horatio Freeman has now in his possession to her and her heirs forever 6^{thly}
I give and bequeath to my daughter Esther Hightower all the property of
mine her husband Jordan Hightower has in his possession to her &
her heirs forever 7^{thly} I give and bequeath to my daughter Sally Sarnett all the
property of mine her husband William Sarnett has now in his possession to
her and her heirs forever 8th my will and done is at the death or mar-
riage of my wife

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her and her heirs forever 8^{thly} my will and desire is that the said
ridge of my wife that the rights negroes that I have lent to my wife
with their increase be valued & also the household and kitchen furniture
and stock of every kind, both been and all my plantations working
tools be sold on a credit of twelve months and that the negroes be equally
divided between my six children, James Hazlewood Daniel Hazlewood,
Betsey Andrews Lucy Faxon and Cashkey Higbourn and Sally Jarratt and
the amount of the sale of the above household and kitchen furniture stock
of every kind both and plantation tools go to my Grand child
dren which is Thomas Jones Children that is one half to my Grand son
William Allen Jones, Joseph Jones, this Jones Benjamin Jones Lucinda Jones
Frederick Jones Henry Jones & Patsey Jones, my meaning and desire is that my
above named children and Grand Children shall have equal portion
that is the six children shall have six sevenths and my Grand
children one seventh each of the amount of the sale of household and kitchen
furniture stock of every kind and plantation tools say William Allen Jones
my Grand son one half of the amount of the sale of the household and
plantation tools and my other

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Betsy Andrews Lucy Farnham and Cooksney
the amount of the sale of the above household and kitchen furniture stock
of every kind Carts and Oxen and plantation tools go to my Grand child
son which is Thomas Jones children that is one half to my Grand son
William Allen Jones, Joseph Jones, Thos Jones, Benjamin Jones, Lucinda Jones
Frederick Jones, Henry Jones & Betsy Jones, my meaning and desire is that my
above named six children and Grand Children shall have equal portion
that is the six children shall have six sevenths and my Grand
children one seventh out of the amount of the sale of household and kitchen
furniture stock of every kind and plantation tools say William Allen Jones
my Grand son one half of the amount of the sale of the household and
kitchen furniture stock of every kind and plantation tools and my other
Grand Children who is mentioned above the other half of the amount
of the sale does not amount to one seventh of the valuation of the above
negroes, and sale of household & kitchen furniture &c. it is not to be made
up out of the above eighteen negroes and if there should be more
than one sixth the surplus to be divided between my above named

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Children, and Grand Children say seventh to be equally divided
 between my Children, and one seventh to my Grand Children
 that is, one half to my Grand son William Allen Jr, and
 the other half to my other Grand Children that is mentioned above
 If my Will or if my wife survives, the above property that I have
 lent her that she shall at her death or marriage let her crop
 of Corn wheat Pot and Peas and all her Bacon, and pork
 come into my Estate and that the same be equally divided be-
 tween my above mentioned Children and Lastly I do hereby
 Constitute, and appoint my sons, James Hazelwood and Daniel
 Hazelwood executors of this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking
 all other former Wills or Testaments by me heretofore made
 In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand, and affixed
 my seal this 12th day of February eighteen hundred & fourteenth
 Signed, Sealed, published & declared
 as and for the last will & Testament
 of the above named Daniel Hazle-
 wood sen. in presence of us

Recorded and in Lunenburg County Court 8th June 1815 The said

Will was further proved by the oath of another Witness thereto subscri-
bed and Ordered to be Recorded and in Lunenburg County Court

8th May 1817 on the petition of Daniel Hazlewood one
of the executors named in the said Will who bearing right
oaths according to Law Certificate is granted him for obtaining

probate of the said Will in due form receiving letters to
James Hazlewood its other next person named to be joined
in the probate whom he shall think fit
