

In the name of God Amen. I Elizabeth Jackson of the County
of Lunenburg being in bad health, but of sound mind I hereby
do make, ordain, constitute & appoint this my last will and
testament in manner & form following. (Viz) First, my
will and desire is that all my debts be first paid. Item 2^d.
I give and bequeath unto my grandson Francis Thompson
Jackson my Negro man Abram to him and his heirs
forever. Also my Potomac house and two cows and calves,
my feather bed & furniture. Item 3^d. I give and bequeath
unto my son Stewart Jackson, One hundred Dollars.
Item 4th. I give and bequeath to my son Benjamin Jackson,
one Dollar. Item 5th. I give and bequeath unto my daughter
Elizabeth, I give and bequeath to be equally divided be-
tween my two daughters Sally Buford and Polly White
to them and their heirs forever. Item 6th and lastly I nominate
and appoint my friend Joel Blackwell Executor to this my
last will and testament hereby revoking, disavowing, and
disannulling all former wills or bequests by me made
before this and this alone to be my last will and testa-
ment in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
the 27th day of June
1828

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In Lunenburg County Court the 8th day of November 1824
 The within written Last will and testament of Elizabeth
 Jackson dec^d was presented in Court and proven by the
 oaths of two of the witnesses thereto subscribed and ordered
 to be recorded - And in Lunenburg Court the 13th December
 following - on the motion of James Blackwell and pr who
 having made oath according to law letters of administration
 with the will annexed is granted him on the Estate of
 Elizabeth Jackson dec^d whereupon he gave bond & security
 for that purpose as the law requires - Joel Blackwell the
 Executor thereof having refused to take upon
 himself the burden of the execution thereof which is ordered
 to be Recorded -
