Testament in manner following (Wiz) All my Just debts to be punctually paid
my Will and desire further is that all my estate both real and personal except
except my house & locks and family Bible, be equally divided between my children
hereafter named to wit, Polly Bouch, Dinah Clarke, Nancy Adams William
I Clarke, Sarah Clarke, Elizabeth Clarke, Peper Clarke, and George Clarke
and the children of my daughter Rhoda Hunt that she now has or may hereafter
have the children of my said daughter Rhoda Hunt are only to draw one
ninth part or one child's part of my estate to be equally divided between them all
and their heirs for life to Lunenburg County Wills 1818-1826
trustees or Guardians appointed by the Court for that special purpose and to be delivered to them severally as
they may come of lawful age or may be applied to them for support or education
as the trustees or Guardians may think proper to my above named children also
the children of my said daughter Rhoda Hunt I give & bequeath the above
bequests to them and to their heirs forever. I give to my son daughter Rhoda Hunt
ten dollars in cash to her & to her heirs forever. My will and desire is that in case
of the death of either of my sons Peper Clarke or George Clarke before they come
to lawful age that then and in that case my will and desire is that all my
estate both real & personal should be equally divided between my said children
hereafter named to wit, Polly Bouch, Dinah Clarke, Nancy Adams William
I Clarke, Sarah Clarke, Elizabeth Clarke & Peper or George Clarke
whichever of them shall may survive & the children of my said daughter Rhoda

hereafter named, to wit, Polley Couch, Quaker Clarke, Nancy Adams & William
H. Clarke, Sarah Clarke, Elizabeth Clarke, Peper Clarke, and George Clarke
and the children of my daughter Rhoda Hunt that she now has or may hereafter
have the children of my said daughter Rhoda Hunt are only to draw one
month part some child's part of my Estate to be equally divided between them all
and their heirs to be deposited in the hands of Trustees or Guardians appointed
by the Court for that special purpose and to be delivered to them severally as
they may come of lawful age or to be applied to their support or education
as the Trustees or Guardians may think proper to my above named children also
the children of my said daughter Rhoda Hunt I give & bequeath the above
bequests to them and to their heirs forever. I give to my said daughter Rhoda Hunt
ten dollars in cash to her & to her heirs forever. I will and desire that in case
of the death of either of my said Peper Clarke or George Clarke before they come
to lawful age that then and in that case my will and desire is that all the
Estate both real & personal should be equally divided between my said 10 children
hereafter named to wit, Polley Couch, Quaker Clarke, Nancy Adams & William
H. Clarke, Sarah Clarke, Elizabeth Clarke & Peper or George Clarke
whichever of them that may survive & the children of my said daughter Rhoda
Hunt always to be understood that the said children of my said daughter
Rhoda Hunt are to draw one child's part to be equally divided between them
as above stated I give to my son George Clarke in house clock and furniture
to him and his heirs forever and to my wife and appointed my loving friends
