In the name of Almighty God Amen.
I, Garrison Smithson of the County of Lunenburg and State
of Virginia being sick but of sound mind and memory do
make constitute and ordain this to be my last will and
testament reaching all things by me herebefore made, in
manner and form following, that is to say.

Item 1st I wish all my Just Debts to be paid.
Item 2. I Will and bequeath, unto my brother in law,
John Wood my bond house, also Three hundred Dollars
in money. to him his heirs and assigns forever.

Item 3. I will and bequeath, that all the rest of my Estate,
of whatsoever kind and name, as well as all monies. To be
equally divided between my brother in law, John Wood,
my brother in law John Wood my brother in law George King,
my Brother Starling J. Smithson and my brother Lewis
Smithson; to them and their heirs and assigns forever.

Item 4th And lastly. I do hereby constitute, and appoint
my brother Starling J. Smithson Executor of this my last
will and testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my seal, this third day of June
in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and
twenty four.

The within written last will and testament of Green Smithson

to law, certificate is granted him for obtaining probate of the
said will in due form, whereupon he entered into and acknowledged
bond with approved security for that purpose conditioned as
the law directs.
