Shelburne, and Elias Shelburne which I give to them and
each of them and their heirs forever

I say I do hereby nominate and appoint my son Elias
Shelburne as my true and lawful executor of the my last will & testament which

all other property hereof given to each of my children
hereafter named in this will to have, convey to them &
each of them and their respective heirs forever
I give unto my beloved wife Anna Shelburne one negro
woman, Fida and her future increase to dispose of at her
own pleasure I also unto my beloved wife before named in this
will all the rest of my estate, real and personal, during
her natural life and at her death it is my will and desire
that all the property left to my wife in this will shall be
equally divided between all my children namely Samson
Redford, Samuel Shelburne, Sally, Crafton Anna Redford,
James Shelburne heirs at law, Hamilton, Billy, Louie, Cottas
Shelburne, and John W. W. which I give to them and
each of them and their heirs forever.
