being at this time weak & low but in my perfect ^{senses} do make this my last will & testament
in the manner form following to wit. I give to my son attorney Henry
Hess all the tract of land whereon I now live containing one hundred &
thirty eight acres also two beds of furniture, I give to my son attorney Henry
Hess two beds of furniture which said beds I have heretofore lent to my daughter
Louise Bragg. I give to my daughter Louise Bragg but shall in least money of
Virginia I also give to the children of my daughter Louise Bragg forty pounds
to be equally divided amongst ^{the children of} said Bragg which he shall have
by my daughter Louise Bragg which said sum of money I have left in the
hands of attorney J. Shaughter to be paid to them as they come to age after
one year and interest to be paid by said attorney J. Shaughter to the above men-
tioned children until they come to age of twenty ^{one} years I give to my son William
Shaughter forty pounds of good Virginia currency which I have left in the hands of
attorney J. Shaughter for him when he comes to the age of twenty one years and
interest to be therein until he becomes to age ²¹ or if the said William
Shaughter my son should have heretofore or should hereafter deal for any
thing which I may be responsible for according to law that his money left
is to be taken so much as will settle any such debt money J. Shaughter is to

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hands of money I thought to be paid to them as they come to age & interest
one year no interest to be paid by said money & thought to the above men-
tioned children until they come to age of twenty ^{one} years I give to my son William

Slughter family of funds Virginia currency which I have left in the hands of
money I thought for him when he comes to the age of twenty one year no
interest to be there until he becomes to age ²⁰ is if the said William
Slughter my son should have hereafter or should hereafter deal for any
thing which I may be responsible for according to law that this money left
is to be taken so much as will settle any such debt money I thought to
have it to pay the debt if any such contracted I nominate & appoint for my
executors money I thought 1810-1812. Payne, I am the father of the said
