will

In the name of God amen I John Winn senior of  
Lunenburg state of Virginia do make & ordain this my last  
will & testament this 29<sup>th</sup> day apr<sup>il</sup> 1819  
Item I direct all my just debts Paid Item I give my  
wife Susanna Winn all my house hold & kitchen furniture all  
my stock of every description my still bagg & plantation utensils  
to do as she may see cause with<sup>in</sup> Item I lend my wife Susanna  
Winn my Negro woman call<sup>d</sup> Lucy Bessmer during the said  
sustained life and at her death I hereby liberate & give her the  
said Lucy Her Freedom & not to be subject to the control of  
any person whatsoever I also give her a bell & a sufficiency for

tives hereafter named out of my estate I confer to my son  
James Winn all the property I have heretofore lett him have  
except a Negro boy by the name of Sebam that he has  
had in his possession several years past on lease & now in his  
possession on a lease I also give him the land he now lives  
on near the river Item I give & confirm unto my son John  
Winn all the property heretofore given him & a Negro  
boy by the name of Jerry whom I confer to my daughter  
Prudence whom the said Sebam was idled to her & by reference  
to the records of our county court of Lunenburg and more  
heretofore I also give to my son John & daughter Prudence

I do & Bolster I do confirm the gift made to my two grand-  
sons James I Brown & Paschall B Brown the 1<sup>st</sup> day this Inst.  
which is of record in Lunsenburg Court I also Give them as here and  
Bolster I do I lend my wife Susanna Winn all my land includ-  
ing Mc Laggans tract also the following slaves to wit Phillis  
Martin Rose, Chancy, Luce, Sally, Isham, Cinday, Easter, Frank, <sup>Rosetta</sup> & Rachel  
during her natural life with all the increase of the females & at the  
death of my wife Susanna Winn I Give my lands to my daughter  
Priscilla Winn. I do so my will & desire that Negroes I loaned my  
wife Susanna Winn (to wit) Phillis Martin Rose Chancy Luce Sally  
Isham Cinday Easter Frank, Rosetta & Rachel after her death be divid-  
ed off in four equal Lots <sup>Lunenburg County Wills 1818-1826</sup> <sup>www.virginiapioneers.net</sup> <sup>as follows</sup> viz. one lot to James Winn  
provided he returns Isham to my estate if not it is my will have no  
further part of the negroes loaned my wife one lot to my son  
John Winn. one lot to my daughter Priscilla Winn one lot  
to my two grand sons James I Brown & Paschall B Brown, I give  
it them & their heirs forever. I do lastly I hereby constitute and  
appoint my beloved wife Susanna Winn & my son John Winn  
my executors & executor revoking all other Wills whatsoever given  
under my hand & seal this day & year above written in the  
presence of Edmund P. Bacon &

 it them & their heirs forever. Item lastly I hereby constitute and

In Lunenburg county court 18<sup>th</sup> september 1821

The within written last will & Testament of John Winn subscribed  
 was presented into court & proved by the oaths of the witnesses  
 thereto subscribed & ordered to be recorded & on the motion of  
 Susanina Winn the executrix named in the said will who having  
 made oath <sup>to law</sup> according a certificate is granted her for obtaining probate of the  
 said will in due form whereupon she gave bond & security <sup>for that that has been</sup> according to law
