said daughter the Tract of land lying on the waters of Meherrin River and deeded
to me by Thomas Gee in exchange of other lands during her life and given to
her children but in case my said daughter should die without children then
then the said land revert back and be equally divided amongst my other
children and their heirs. Item I lend to my Grand daughter Martha Ragdale
one negro Girl named Cate the younger during her life and at her death the
said negro Cate and her increase to be equally divided between her children
if any but if no child the said negro to return back and be equally divided

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I sell one negro man named Will also one negro girl named
his heirs forever and also the land where in I now live and also my land on
Bear Creek. I give and bequeath to my daughter Rachel Lee two negroes
To wit, Phillis Ester and their increase to her and her heirs forever. I also lend my
said daughter the Tract of land lying on the waters of Meherrin River and deeded
to me by Thomas Gee in exchange of other lands, during her life and given to
her children but in case my said daughter should die without Children then
then the said Land revert back and be equally divided amongst my other
Children and their heirs. Item I lend my grand daughter Martha Rayburn
one negro Girl named ~~Esther~~ ^{the} ~~girl~~ ^{girl} during her life and at her death the
said negro Girl and her increase to be equally divided between her Children
if any but if no Child the said Negro to return back and be equally divided
by my other Children and their heirs. I also give my said grand
daughter twenty pounds to be paid out of any money I may leave or have
out my Estate I lend to my grand daughter Patsy during her life one
negro boy named Patten during his life and at his death the said boy
and his increase to be equally divided between his Children

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if any, but if no children, the said Negro to return back and be
equally divided by my execs. between my children and their heirs my
Will and decree further is that at the death or marriage of my said
Wife that my execs. hereafter named divided the stock of all kinds
movables and fixtures and Plantations both equally between
my daughter Mary Gee, my son William Gee, and my daughter Betsy
Gee, on the survivors of them. I give and bequeath my son Benjamin Gee
