

No 1412 I, David Lee of the County of Lunenburg and State of Virginia do make
Will, my will in the following manner that is to say - I Give to my son
George I Lee One hundred & four teen Valuable acres of land whereon the mortgage
on the following conditions (Viz) that between said George I Lee shall pay
to each of my other sons when they come to the age of twenty one years the one
fifth part of the value of the land at the time he receives it - Also I give to my
son George I Lee one bay horse named Wander which is now in his possession
2^d I Give to my wife Elizabeth Lee the whole of the land whereon the mortgage
and all my negroes, stock, plantation utensils Corn fodder & Oats during her
life or so long as she shall live except the stock sold to pay my debts if any be so & but
it is my will and desire that my son William I Lee Alfred Lee John
- Thomas Lee & David Lee of them have a riding horse Comm-
on saddle & bridle from what is made from what I have found my wife
by Cropping or raising Colts if it can be done & she & family well supported
But if that cannot be done before she dies or gets married they each must have
a riding horse on the value of one out of my estate and not to be accountable
for the same in the final division between my children 3rd It is my will
and desire that my son Alfred Lee shall have one year's schooling & my sons
John Thomas Lee & David Lee shall have an education equal to their
other brothers & that to be done out of the profits made from the property I own
- as to my wife & 4th It is my desire that the crops of tobacco now made
and the crops that shall be made this year be applied to the payment
of debts but if my wife & 5th It is my desire that they may sell part of

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order touching that to be done out of the profits made from the property loan-
ed to my wife. It is my desire that the crops of slaves now made
and the crops that shall be made this year be applied to the pay ment
of debts but if my wife & her friends think proper they may sell part of
the stock to discharge my debts - & it is my desire and will that my
wife & her friends may give to each Legatee when they marry or arrive to
the age of twenty one years a certain part of the Estate loaned my wife
and that each Legatee shall have an equal part given as nearly as
can be ascertained by valuation & what each receives he or they shall be
accountable at the General division & I desire the whole of my estate
that I have not given away as above at the death or marriage of my wife
Legatee be to be equally divided among my sons George & John & William
& Alfred & John & I desire to go to them and
their heirs for ever & lastly I appoint my son George & John
and my brother Lucian & John to this my last will & Testament
