County; proposing sound health and memory do make and Ordain this
my last will & Testament: Inpursue after the payment of just debts I
dispose of my Estate both real & personal in the following manner to wit I give
all the slaves, lands and other property which I have heretofore given to any of my
children, I do confirm such gift to them and their heirs forever. Item I give &
bequeath to my son Edward all my one my plantation (Garrison Swamp Creek,
which comprehends all the land thereon by the course of a wide river including
the lands I purchased of the Estate of Thomas Lane & do to him & his heirs

Item I also give and bequeath to my said son Edward M. Jones the
 following negroes to wit: Harriett, Betty, Delia, Betsy, Rhoda, and
 Moses including the increase of the females to him and his heirs forever
 Item I also give and bequeath to my said son Edward M. Jones his
 feather Beds and furniture, the head of ~~beds~~, a box of ~~clothes~~
 Cash, ~~the~~ ^{two} ~~beds~~, and twenty head of hogs to him and his heirs forever
 Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Susanna Jones the following
 negroes to wit: Rene, Hamilton, Rose, Fanny, and her two children
 (Patsy & Sally) and Loretta, including the future increase of the
 females, to her and ~~her heirs forever~~ Item I give and bequeath to my
 said daughter Susanna Jones two feather Beds & furniture, and a
 horse bridle and Saddle to her and her heirs forever Item I give and

and saddle to her and ~~her~~ and her heirs forever. Item I give and be-
queath to my grand daughter Martha C. Robertson, a negro girl named Ann
and her increase to her and her heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to
my daughter Sally Cralle, wife of Richard K. Cralle two hundred pounds
current money in consideration of any debts, dues or demands which he
now has or may in future have against me either by bond or open

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herefore I leave the residue of my Estate of whatsoever kind or whatsoever form that may remain after the death of my said wife Jane Jones, I give and bequeath to be equally divided amongst my following eight children to wit Branch Jones, Samuel Jones Peter Jones Elizabeth Taylor, Susanna Jones, Eden and all Jones & ~~Samuel Jones & Peter Jones & Elizabeth Taylor & Susanna Jones~~ and their

heirs forever I leave my will, and desire is that my daughter Susanna Jones Ann Jones and Francis Jones do continue to live with my wife Jane Jones till their marriage and that they be permitted to continue their negroes on the Land left to my wife Jane Jones, but without receiving any thing for their Labor except a comfortable support I leave my will and desire is that my two grand sons John Robertson & David J. Robertson be raised and Educated out of my Estate as far as will qualify them for Ordaining I leave the two hundred pounds hereinafter bequeathed to my daughter Sally Cradle wife of Richard K. Cradle is not to be paid her till it can be conveniently raised by my Executors after the death of my said wife Jane Jones I leave I desire that there be no appraisement of my Estate And I do hereby appoint my sons Samuel Jones & Edward M. Jones and John Taylor Executors to this my Last Will & Testament In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 9th day of December 1813
