I give two children by name little Berry Wynn and Hanson
Wynn three Negroes to wit I give to her and her heirs forever but
I give to her equally divided between them when little
Berry Wynn arrives to the age of twenty one to them and
their heirs forever and their future increase I then I give and
bequeath to my daughter Mary H. Wynn One negro boy Anderson
to her and her heirs forever. I then I give and bequeath to my
daughter Lucy Wilkes two Negroes to wit Wm. H. B. B. and
her future increase to her and her heirs forever. I then I give to
and bequeath to my daughter Victoria Barnett four negroes
to wit I give, Jack Phile and Peter and their future
increase to her and her heirs forever. I then I give to my
daughter Polly I give One negro boy by name E. H. and

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her future increase to her and her heirs forever. I then give and bequeath
to my son Richard Stone two negroes by name Bob and Rhoda Maney
~~children and the future increase of Rhoda to~~
him and his heirs forever. I then give and bequeath to my son ~~Thomaston~~
two negroes to wit Matt and Ben and one Bed and furniture to him
and his heirs forever. I then give and bequeath to my daughter Louisa
Wilkes two negroes to wit Sally and Issa and her future increase to her

Bed and furniture and the future increase of Ester to him and his

negroes to wit Frank, Isaac, old Jim, young Jim, Lewis, Jupiter, Harriet
Jacob, old Harriah and Perry Harriah and their future increase to her
and her heirs forever also I give to my wife all my stock of cattle, hogs,
horses, sheep, my blacksmith tools, still house and kitchen furniture
and plantation utensils after my debts are paid also I leave my wife
the land whereon I now live during her natural life also my

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Will and desire is that after my wife's death the Land be equally divided
between my Three sons by name Richard Stone Thomas Stone and
Peter W Stone to them and their heirs forever Item Lastly I do hereby
appoint my wife and Com^{rs} Wm Wm on my Last
