
I, the subscriber, Robert Smith, of a full age, and sound mind, do make this my  
last will and testament, in manner as follows, witnessed and sealed  
in presence of me, that all my just debts to be justly paid  
by my Executor before I am delivered up the last joint  
of my body, and I do hereby disaffirm all former

and family to be disposed of as my said father deceased may direct  
at the death the stocks to be put up to my best bidders to my own account  
whereas my said friends take in their debts left to the hands of my executors  
put to interest until they or other arrives to liquidate same or in case of  
such time to draw them paid to them and then have given over to  
said friends whoe and myself to draw the interest of their past due in the  
hands of my executors further of my said stocks to be sold off or else  
liquidated above the labours he makes that part family I appoint my  
uncles Joshua Smith and John B Chappell my executors given under  
my hand and seal this 10 day of May one thousand eight hundred and  
twentynine

Six Lunenburg County Court - 10<sup>th</sup> July 1820. The will above written  
last sealed and testament of Robert Smith as was presented into court &  
the same was proved by the oaths of one of the witnesses thereto subscribed  
and ordered to be Certified - And at a Court held for Lunenburg County  
the 13<sup>th</sup> day of November 1820. The said will was again presented into court  
and proved by the oaths of the other witness thereto subscribed and ordered to be  
recorded. Also on the motion of Carter Paydale letters of administration  
is granted him with the will annexed whereupon he gives bond and  
security and qualifies as the law directs to the sum of
