I the Robert S Smith of Loudoun Co Va make and ordain this my
will last will and testament in manner and form following in these
first place I give that all my last estate to be parcelled out
by my Executors hereafter named. I hereby disinherit & release of
my property whatever it may consist of to be sold for the best price
that can be obtained. I then direct the same to be equally divided
into three equal parts one of which I leave in trust in the hands
of the said Executors to be paid to my wife

and finally to be disposed of as my said father Francis Smith may direct
at his death the other two parts I give to my two sisters Nancy and Rachel
to be equally divided between them to be left in the hands of my executor to be
put to interest until they or either arrives to lawfull age or intermarriage
at which time to draw them parts to them and then have forever in their
own time while under age to draw the interest of these parts under the
direction of my executor if either of my said sisters be under age or attain
lawfull age the survivors to have that part - lastly I appoint my
uncles Joshua Smith and John C. Chappell my executors under
my hand and seal the 12th day of May one thousand eight hundred and
twenty -

In Lunenburg County Court 10th July 1820. The will then written
last will and testament of Robert Smith dec^d was presented into Court &
the same was proved by the oaths of one of the witnesses thereto subscribed
and ordered to be Certified - And at a Court held for Lunenburg County
the 13th day of November 1820. The said will was again presented into Court
and proved by the oaths of the other witness thereto subscribed and ordered to be
recorded Also on the motion of Parster Rapdole letter of administration
is granted him with the well annexed whereupon he gave bond and
security and qualified as the law directs &c
