In Lunenburg County Court 10 January 1823
The within written last will and testament of Stephen
Brown dec^d was presented in Court and proved by the oaths
of two of the witnesses thereto subscribed and ordered to be
recorded, and Jonas Allen the Executor therein named refused
to take upon himself the burthen of the execution thereof
and on his motion letters of administration is granted him
on the Estate of the said decedent with the will annexed
whereupon he gave bond and security for that purpose
according to Law.
