

Will of Col^o Edward Jordan dec^d. In the name of God Amen: I Susanna Jordan widow
of Col^o Edward Jordan dec^d. bring in my senses at this
time & enjoying my memory, do make and ordain this to be
my last will and Testament, hereby revoking all other Wills
by me made. In the first place all my Just debts are to
be paid by my Executor.

Item I give & bequeath to my son Sabon Jordan one half of all
my Estate, (as well all money, to which I am in anywise
entitled unto at my death, as also all Interest and emoluments
that I may be entitled unto by virtue of the last will &
Testament of my deceased husband, and which at the time
of my death may still be due and owing to me,) forever.

Lunenburg County Wills 1818-1826
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Item I give and bequeath unto my two daughters, Mary
Saffers; and Susanna Petrus, two thirds of the other half
of my estate to be equally divided between them forever
& I give to my son William Jordan the other one third of
the other half of all my estate forever.

Item I give to my daughter Susanna Petrus my side
Saddle forever.

Item I give to the daughters of said Susanna Petrus all my
wearing apparel forever.

Item I direct that my Estate shall not be appraised and
that my executor shall not be compelled to give security
in the last will & Testament.

I give and bequeath unto my two daughters Mary
Jeffrey and Susanna Pettus two thirds of the other half
of my estate to be equally divided between them forever
I give to my son Miles Jordan the other one third of
the other half of all my estate forever.

I give to my daughter Susanna Pettus my side
saddle forever.

I give to the daughters of said Susanna Pettus all my
wearing apparel forever.

I direct that my estate shall not be appraised and
that my executor shall not be compelled to give security
for the performance of this my last will & Testament.

I do hereby ~~nominate~~ appoint my son Labon
Executor of this my last will & Testament: In testimony whereof
I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 4th
day of May nineteenth eight hundred & twenty three
