In the name of God amen I Thomas Crafton senr. of Lunenburg
County and State of Virginia being sick & weak of body, but of a sound
and disposing mind and memory revoking all former wills heretofore made by
me do make this my last will & Testament in the manner & form following
That is to say that all my Just debts should be first paid and after my debts
is paid I leave to my beloved wife Mary Crafton all the rest of my property both
Real and personal during her natural life or widowhood and after my
wifes death or widowhood I leave to my daughter Elizabeth Powers
one fifth of my property I leave to my wife during her natural
life and my daughters share of the property I leave to be equally divided
between her children that she has by John Powers and her children
by Mr. Thomas Powers her present husband so that each of them has an equal
part to them & their heirs forever. I leave I give the balance of my
property from fifth after my wifes death or widowhood to be equally
divided between my four children by name Anderson Crafton, Thomas
Crafton, Thomas Crafton & Thomas Crafton to them & their heirs forever
I leave my will that my wife shall have the choice of what she
will the land or negroes to help towards paying my debts &
some other my beloved wife Mary Crafton and my sons & daughters
