named bonds be incompetent for the purpose for which they  
are assigned to is my will & pleasure that the balance

after discharging all my Just debts I give and bequeath  
the said to my loving brother Wm Brown also I give and  
bequeath unto him all and every part of my property whatever  
- even excepting my negro boy Charles - I then give & bequeath  
unto my loving sister Nancy & Jane Brown and my loving  
Brother Jesse Brown the monies which arise from the hire  
of Charles until Jesse Brown becomes of age at which  
time it is my will and pleasure that Charles shall be  
sold on a credit of Twelve Months and the monies arising  
from said sale to be equally divided between my two  
sisters above mentioned and my brother Jesse Brown

do this, I desire all my just debts to be fully paid off  
and charged for which purpose I assign a bond due me from  
Thomas Manson of fifty five dollars also one other bond due  
from John Rives of seventy dollars to be collected by my executors & to be  
applied to the discharge of my debts & should claim two above  
named bonds be incompetent for the purpose for which they  
are assigned it is my will & pleasure that the balance  
be raised out of monies which are due on open accounts &  
for the sale of groceries & if there should be any monies remaining  
after discharging all my just debts I give and bequeath  
the same to my loving brother Wm Brown also I give and  
bequeath unto him all and my part of my property whatever  
- ever excepting my negro boy Charles - I then give & bequeath  
unto my loving sister Nancy & Jane Brown and my loving  
brother Simeon Brown the monies which come from the sale  
of Charles since Simeon Brown became of age at which  
time it is my will and pleasure that Charles shall be  
sold on a credit of twelve months and the monies arising  
from said sale to be equally divided between my two  
sisters above mentioned and my brother Simeon Brown  
and finally I do nominate & appoint my brother  
Wm Brown executor of this my last will &  
testament but without whom I do hereby assign

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my hands and seals this the 28<sup>th</sup> of March in the year of our Lord 1823 signed sealed and delivered in the presence of

In Lunenburg County Court the day of April 1826 The within and last Will and testament of Thomas H. Brown dec'd was presented into Court and the same proved by the oaths of two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of R. M. Brown the record was made by the Clerk who having made oaths according to said certificate is granted him for obtaining probate of said will in due form whereupon he entered into and acknowledged bond conditioned as the law directs
