

Freeman Thomas In the name of God amen I Throver Freeman of the County of  
Lunenburg being in proper mind and memory do make this  
my last will & Testament & revoking all others. First I bequeath my  
soul to god who gave it - as to my worldly goods I give more largely  
as follows to wit: To my son Edward R. Freeman a negro girl by  
the name of Chelise also I give to my son Ead<sup>r</sup> R. Freeman a  
certain tract of land lying being of Robert Atkinson and  
of a Kobuep which fell to my wife Jane which belong to me  
for life if any of my other children claims any part of the  
above mentioned land that they shew not draw any of my world  
-ly goods. Then I give unto my son Ed<sup>r</sup> R. Freeman my Garnet tract of  
land to him & his heirs forever. I also give unto my wife & curse that my  
daughters Elizabeth J. Freeman & Martha M. Ann Freeman and  
Charlotte M. Freeman - Then my three last mentioned daughters  
shall have a home on the tract of land which I now reside  
unless they become of age or marry. Then I give it  
to my son Ed<sup>r</sup> R. Freeman also a negro boy by the name of Tom  
also a negro girl by the name of Lucy. Then I give unto my  
daughter Martha M. Ann Freeman a negro girl by the name  
of Patience. Then I give to my daughter Charlotte M. Freeman  
a negro girl by the name of Urania. I give unto my  
daughter Mary M. Ann a negro woman & child by the  
name of Ruth. Then I give to my son Edward R.

I gave one bed and furniture to my son John & I gave one bed and furniture to my daughter Eliza & I gave one bed & furniture to my daughter Martha & I gave one bed and furniture to my daughter Charlotte & I gave my three youngest daughters two hundred dollars a piece naming Elizabeth & I named Martha & I named Charlotte & I named after paying my debts every thing not herein mentioned to be equally divided amongst my six children. This being my last will & testament I set my hand & seal this seventh day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twenty three
