At a Court held for Mecklenburg County the 15 day of February  
1781

The Will being produced in Court without any date there  
John P. Smith & Mary Beach two of the witnesses  
therein declared on oath that since the testator seal  
& signed the said Will about the year 1778  
& that he was of sound mind and memory at  
the time he so signed & believed when upon the said Will  
was being to be sworn in before the motion of  
Robert Jones the executor named in the will

Both Rhoads and together with John Marshall & William  
Christopher his immediate successors into and acknowledge  
that some of the penalty of fifty thousand pounds  
imposed as the Law Directs Confiscation was granted him  
for obtaining a probat thereof in due form  
Wm. Rhoads John Brown 1861
