shillings current money out of my Estate to be paid her by my Executors. - Then I Give to my
son Isaac three one feather bed and bed seats. - Then I Give to my

Shillings current money out of my Estate to be paid here by my Executors. - I have I give to my
son Joel Chandler twenty Shillings current money out of my Estate to be paid here by my
Executors. - I have I give to my Daughter Patsy Chandler twenty Shillings current
money out of my Estate to be paid here by my Executors. - Also I do appoint my loving
wife Mary Chandler and my son David Chandler Executors of this my last will and
