Testament

I hereby give and bequeath my whole estate both real estate to my wife Mary Clements during her widowhood. I also give give and bequeath to my son John Clements after the marriage or death of his mother my Tract of Land whereon I now live to him and his heirs forever. I also give to my son John Clements a negro woman named Melly after the marriage or death of his mother to him and his heirs forever. I also give and bequeath to my son James Clements after the death or marriage of his mother a negro boy named Harry to him and his heirs forever.

I also give and bequeath to my son Edmund Clements after the marriage or death of his mother a negro boy named Tony to him and his heirs forever and my desire is that if the above named Melly

should have any more children before the marriage or death of my

said wife that they be equally divided among my three children

all my household & kitchen furniture be equally divided after the
marriage or death of my said wife among my three children
before mentioned. I nominate and appoint Samuel Hopkins
and Nicholas Belto executors of this my last will and Testament
revoking and disannulling all former will or wills by me made.

At a Court held for Mecklenburg County the 8th day of August 1785

This Will was proved by the Oaths of Zachariah Spurlough & Joseph Hamilton witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of Samuel Hopkins' jur. Gent one of the execs therein named who made oath thereto and together with Samuel Threlkeld Gent his security entered into & acknowledged their Bonds in the penalty of one thousand pounds conditioned as the Law directs certificate was granted him for obtaining a patent of the said Will in due form liberty being reserved for the other executors therein named to join in the probat when he shall think fit
