the death of my loving wife that all the rest of my estate be
set up and sold at the highest bidder by my executors and of
all and the money equally divided among my children and
last of all I do appoint Thomas Bulbreath and John Munro
Holey and Soley executors of my estate this my last will &
testament given under my hand and seal this 5 day of
October 5706. my will and desire is that my estate shall
not be appraised after my death
