In obedience to the decree annexed to the proceedings of the worshipful  
 Court of Middlebury County bearing date October Court 1823 (see)  
 the subscribers met at the dwelling house of Martha Simon accompanied  
 by the County Surveyor on the 28 of October 1823 & proceeded to divide  
 the land belonging to the Orphans of Dabney Phelps dec'd. the tract  
 containing after the widows dower 430 acres 104 poles which we  
 divided agreeable to quality & quantity according to each claimant  
 as follows viz to Susan J Phelps Lot No. 1 containing 72  
 acres valued to \$3.39 1/2 to Lucy J Phelps Lot 2 containing  
 61 acres 120 poles valued to \$4.50 and 6 acres to John

to Albert & Philip the sum of \$115.94 and also that Jane  
& Philip pay Martha & Philip in like manner the sum  
of \$159 1/2 to Charles & Philip the sum of \$86.66  
and to Albert & Philip the sum of \$124.00 and further state  
that we have given to the Complainant Charles & Philip  
his just portion of the Estate both real & personal given  
under our hands the 16 Jan 1824.
