Law to the testator who acknowledged the validity of the
same and it appearing to the Court to be the Testator's
hand writing it was ordered that the same be
read and on the motion of the said John Bushnell
that ~~John Bushnell~~ the ~~same~~ ~~person~~ named who made
Oath thereto and together with the said Dorset their
severally entered into and acknowledged their bond
in the penalty of one thousand pounds conditioned as
the said Bushnell Certificate was granted them for
obtaining a probat thereof in due form
