receive the same again by the mighty power of God and as touching
my worldly goods or estate I give and dispose of in manner and
form following. I Will and bequeath to my Wife Brambley
my estate Real and personal moveables and immoveables during
her life or widowhood then I will that what is then remaining
shall be equally divided between my seven Children or as
many of them as shall be then living (viz) my two sons
Bennett Watson and Isaac Watson and five daughters Mary
Rebecca, Fanny, Tabitha and Martha Watson. Lastly I
Appoint Anthony Bennett and Joseph Bennett Junr
Executors of this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby
disallow revoke and disannul all other Wills or Testa-
ments and Confirm this to be my last In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourteenth day
of October 1782
