Wise I desire I direct that all my Just debts may be fully paid
as soon as possible. Then I give my land and all the rest of
my estate that I do possess of to my two Sisters Lucy
Bugg and Betty Hopkins and to their heirs to be equally
divided between the said two Sisters Lucy Bugg & Betty
Hopkins but if either of my two Sisters die without issue
the said Sisters part of my Land and other estate above
mentioned shall return to the issue of the other Sister -

I hereby appoint Colonel James Hopkins my Executor &
my Sister Lucy Bugg Executrix of this my last will and
Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this seventeenth day May 1787.

At about field for Marlborough County the 3rd day of February 1880
This will was produced in Court by James Hopkins junior Gent.
~~The executor therein named and the being as Witnesses to the~~
same James Gadsden, Robt. Pinchall and James Hogg being
sworn severally deposed that they are well acquainted with the
Testators hand writing and verily believe that the said will and
the name thereto subscribed are all the said Testators proper
hand writing. Whereupon the said will was ordered to be
recorded. and on the motion of the said executor who made
oath thereto and together with Richard Taylor his security
entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of
five thousand pounds Conditioned as the law directs. Certificate
was granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due
form; liberty being reserved for Lucy Bugg the executrix
therein named to join in the probat when she shall think
fit
