manner at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned
In witness whereof I have all my just Birth and funeral Expenses to
be duly discharged

60. The said John for himself and heirs that he and his
heirs were formerly the owners of the said land
the said land and to be the same land in the
possession of James Westwood before he died then
James Westwood married a woman called Ruth and entered
into and acknowledged with due authority and consent
them to be his wife a certain person in the year
1769 John Westwood.

A deed of the said Westwood to James Green of the same
county on the day of December 1769. Test.
That he the said James Westwood did give and deliver
with him the said land that he bought
of Benjamin said again the said land of him in
the year and that he the said Benjamin

A. that of 20.00 made by Isaac Brown of Salisbury
 County on the night of the day of the 10th of December 1769. That
 that he should have been made aware that his father
 and brother should divide the land that he bought
 of Benjamin Davis equally, between himself and
 Nathan and that he should have been made aware
 of the same. Isaac Brown asked how his brother
 and son of land and divide that between his other two
 children, meaning that in order as well as that
 already been said that his wife Thelma Brown
 should have all the remainder of the land to a
 fair and children. Information of the fact of the
 the children have asked that should be
 done by the 10th day of December 1769.
