This will was proved by the Oaths of Joel Moore & Elizabeth Arnold
Witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded And on the motion of
Elisha Arnold one of the executors therein named who made oath
thereto and together with John Arnold his security entered into and
acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of five hundred pounds
conditioned as the Landrocks certificate was granted him for
obtaining a probat of the said will in due form And John Arnold
the other executor therein named personally appeared in Court
and refused to take upon himself the execution of the said will
and the said Joel Moore and Elizabeth Arnold were sworn
and deposed that this will was signed the eleventh day of last
month (October)
