Know all men by these presents that I Joseph Knight of Washington
County do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner
and form following To wit, My Will and desire is that all my Just Debts
and necessary Expenses be first paid by selling such a part of my Estate as
My Executors shall think most convenient. Then I Give and bequeath to
William Woodson Andrews two hundred and fifty pounds Current Money of
Virginia to be raised out of my Estate by the Sale of my Negroes and Stock
To be continued on the same place where I now live, but if he the said William
W Andrews should be before he arrives to lawful Age or Marry then he
shall only have as much of the above named sum of Money as shall be
sufficient to maintain him during his life and give him good Education
I also give the toll that came of my Negroes more to the said William W Andrews
Then I Give unto Winifred Andrews Mother of the above said William
Twenty pounds Current Money to be raised out of my Estate. Then I Give
and bequeath unto Sarah Pinner my Negro wife to her and her heirs
Forever. Then I Give and bequeath unto my Brother Jonathan Knight
and his heirs forever after the above named Legacies are raised all my
Estate both Real and Personal, also if there should be any of the same
