

On a line held for Mecklenburg County the 10th of May 1778
There were present by the order of Edy Malahell and
Peterson Dinkler Christopher Thurst. & desired to be recorded
and on the motion of John Dinkler and Samuel Puckett
one of the committee therein named who made oath thereto
& together with John Malahell & William Hatchell their
several names & interest with any other acknowledged these bonds
in the presence of one thousand persons considered as
the same directed & testified was granted them for obtaining
a patent therefor in due form of law & being recorded for
the other committee therein named to join in perfect when he
shall think fit

Puckett of the said county of Mecklenburg
being the said much in duty with the

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I have sold to my beloved wife Anne Greenwood the land
whereon I live also two mares together with all my stock of
cattle and sheep three feather beds & furniture & all other
household furniture also two Negroes to wit Charles and Cai-
daway two natural life & then to be sold & the money arising
from the sale thereof to equally divided among my five
children to wit Mary, Thomas, James, Fanny & Henry Green
and my will is that the residue of my Negroes be equally
divided among my said five children when my son
Thomas Greenwood shall arrive to twenty one years of age
and I empower my executor hereafter named to sell all my
feather beds and furniture also one young black man
what I call in made & live in the barn & further intent
is that if my wife shall think proper to remove from
the said land I live on I do empower my executor to do
the same and purchase a nether tract for her and after
her death I desire my executor to sell the same & the
money arising from the sale to equally divided among
my five children.

Mecklenburg County, Virginia Wills 1765-1782
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I have translated and appointed my friend Thompson
and my beloved D. the Thomas Greenwood

and my beloved Brother Thomas Greenwood my sole
executor and trustee to see my last will & testament
executing all other wills do proclaim & declare this my
last will and testament Sir Writings whereof I have
put my hand and seal this twentieth day of April one
thousand seven hundred & seventy eight
against sealed proclaimed
and delivered before us.

At a Court held for Mecklenburg County the 5 day of June 1778
This Will was proved by the oath of David Royds & Distiller
Thomas W. Ingles the latter ordered to be recorded & on the motion
of Thomas Greenwood one of the executors therein named who
came with Bonds and together with Jeremiah Tamm
his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in
the penalty of one thousand pounds conditioned as the
said certificate was granted him for obtaining a probate

of the same with several forms liberty being reserved for the
 other members thereof named to join in the probate when
 he shall think fit
