dollars - Committed together with the Plantation
on the North side of river Back from the town
of ... and to be partitioned above the plantation
between and his heirs forever and to his heirs forever

to him and his heirs forever and he shall pay unto
his brother William the two hundred pounds
of money the sum and bequeath unto my son
the one hundred acres of Land by Impetration
part of the same tract on the same side of the said
said tract from the first tract above the plantation
to be appoynted to him and his heirs forever only
he shall pay unto his brother William the sum
of one hundred pounds of Virginia
the sum and bequeath unto my son William the
one hundred acres of Land by Impetration
part of the same tract lying on the south side
of the tract of the said said tract to him and his heirs

from Idleness into my all beloved wife Elizabeth
like all the virtues of every good woman, in which she
was almost perfect these years which have been the
time to become according to their Birth Right and now
will is that my wife Elizabeth shall not be
from wanting tending or improving many other
privilege that she should upon the said land have
of her life or here had and after the Decease there be
any more left will is that it shall be Equally
amongst my Daughters. Mary Miles and Elizabeth

At a Court held for Mecklenburg County the 11th day of June 1782
Petition will and Testament of Robert Miles deceased

Petition of Elizabeth Miles one of the Executors thereon
made and made Oath and entered into and returned
with security as the law directs Intestate is
granted her for Obtaining Probate of the said Will

in a uniform. Reserving liberty to the Other
Executive Power. Named when he shall arrive
to the age of twenty one years.
