In the name of God Amen the fifteenth day of October one thousand
seven hundred and ninety I Sarah Poindester of St. James Parish
the Parish of Cambridge being in a low state of health but of sound mind
and memory thanks to Almighty God and Father to me and my own
family and knowing that it is requisite for all Christians I there-
fore make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner
and form following (Viz) first of all I Recommend my soul into
the hands of God that gave it and my body to the Earth to be
Buried in a Christian manner at the Discretion of my Executors
hereafter to be named first I desire that all my Just Debts may be
paid by my Executors. — I then Give to my beloved son
George Cymas Poindester the Land whereon I now live containing
three hundred Acres be the same more or less and one Negro man
named Jupiter and one feather bed and furniture to him and his
Heirs forever. — I then Give to my son John Poindester one share

of my ~~estate~~ ^{fortune} in my way to the earth to be
Buried in a Christian manner at the Discretion of my Executors
— Hereafter to be named first I desire that all my Just Ditts may be
paid by my Executors. — — — I give to my beloved son
George Gydes Poindeston the Land whereon I now live containing
three hundred Acres be the same more or less and one Negro man
named ~~Leibel~~ ^{Leibel} and one feather bed and furniture to him and his
Heirs forever. — — — I give to my son John Poindeston one Negro
man named ~~Wot~~ ^{Wot} one feather bed and furniture and fifteen pounds
Cash to him and his heirs forever. — — — I give to Daughter Mary
Charlotte Gydes one Negro man named ~~Bob~~ ^{Bob} to her and her heirs forever
I give to my Daughter Belcy Ann Peltus two Negroes named
Easter and Will and very large Walnut Table to her and her heirs
forever. — — — I give to my Daughter Martha Poindeston two
Negroes named Harry and addam one horse saddle and bridle one
feather bed and furniture to her and her heirs forever. — — —

Then I give to my Daughter Mary Hephons Pinder the negro named Joseph
and Peter one Horse Saddle and bridle and one feather bed and furniture when
and her heirs forever. Then I solemnly appoint my Friends William Wells

Green, Samuel Bevier, John and Thomas Sellers Executors of this my last
Will and Testament I declare to be the last the last Will and Testament of

Sarah Pinder and her request in all the same
