as is already noted & to be peaceably possessed and enjoyed by
him the said Thomas Carleton him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son Gabriel Carleton all the re-
maining part of my land lieing that part whereon Inacolon
and Ocupe lie peaceably possessed and enjoyed by him the
said Gabriel Carleton him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Arenton one
negro boy named Jane lieing the negro she hath now in

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Susannah Cox one
negro girl named Dolly together with two cows & calves & two
cows & lambs to her the said Susannah Cox her and her
heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Rebekah Carleton
one negro girl named Rose together with one horse & colt
commonly known by the name of Figure two cows & calves
two cows and lambs and one feather bed and furniture to
the said Rebekah Carleton her and her heirs forever.

Item I find to my beloved wife Sarah Cartton the remainder
-ing part of my whole estate both real and personal during her
widowhood together with that part of the land when on Inure
