one Feather bed two Cows & Calves and half of my Negro woman
called Betty which I have delivered to her and it is the whole of my
Estate I intend for her I Item I give to my daughter Hannah
the other half of my Negro woman & money already delivered.

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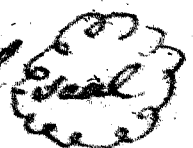

whole & Sole Executrix of this my Last Will and my Will and

Security for this my Estate nor will I have any part of my Estate
