my Children shall arrive at the age of Twenty one years and that

as they come to such an age they shall have their parts resp-  
 ectively paid them and I further desire that all my Children  
 be under the management and direction of my said Executors  
 revoking all other Wills I have made to be my last and the  
 way I desire my Estate and Children to be disposed of I do  
 this 5<sup>th</sup> day of March 1748

Creditor Administration of the said Deceased's Estate with  
the Will annexed is granted him he having first perform-  
ed what the Law in that Case doth require
