and bequeath unto my son Nicholas Bristow one Negro man named
Jas. to him and his heirs I Am I give & bequeath unto my Daughter
Ann Bristow one Negro woman named Bess with her Cras to her and
her heirs for ever I Am I give & bequeath unto my grandson John
Bristow one of Tho. Bristow one Negro boy named Major to him
and his heirs I Am I give & bequeath unto William Owen one of
Michael Owen one Negro garle named Lotty her & her Increase for
ever I Am I give & bequeath unto my son William Bristow one
Negro garle named Ross her & her Increase for ever I Am I give
& bequeath unto my son James Bristow one Negro woman named
Gincy her & her Increase for ever I Am I give & bequeath unto my two
sons Nicholas & James Bristow my land to be equally divided between
them & their heirs for ever I Am I give and bequeath my
hole personal estate to equally divided between my wife & children
after my debts first paid & lastly I appoint my sons Nicholas
and James Bristow Executors of this my last will & testament
as witness my hand & seal this 20th day of Sept. 1686.
