personall) that it hath pleased Almighty God to give me to be-
lieve with all I give devise and bequeath the same as follows that is
to say I give devise unto my 1st Son Arthur W. all my
plantations and Tract of Land with the Appurtenances and
Houseswell to him and the heirs of his body lawfully begotten
& for want of such Issue to my two younger Sons John & Henry
W. successively in like manner. And my will is that my said Son
Arthur be capacitated to enjoy my said plantation when he shall
attain the full Age of Eighteen. But my will is that my dear
wife Mary W. May quietly Enjoy the third of my said land
during her Natural life. And I give unto my said Dear wife
my Negro woman called Sarah, and the first Child my Negro woman
called Nancy shall next after the decease of this will be bound
up to have and enjoy the same during her Natural life in
lieu of her third of my Negro woman given unto my said Son
Arthur my Negro woman Nancy and my Negro girl Sarah
to enjoy the same to him and his heirs forever. I shall give
the third Child of my 1st Negro Nancy if it shall happen she may
have such to my said Son John W. and his heirs forever.
I shall give the first Child of my said Negro Sarah to my
Daughter Anne W. and her heirs forever. And I give to
my said Son Henry W. the fourth Child of my said Negro
Nancy to him and his heirs forever. And my will is
before is that my said Son Arthur W. when he shall be
of Age to enjoy my land as above. And take my two sons
John and Henry to live and labour with him till they

Attain the full Age of Eighteen. But my will is that my dear
wife Mary Nafle May quietly enjoy the third of my said land
during her Natural life. And I Give unto my said Dear wife
my Negro woman called Sarah, and the first Child my Negro woman
Called Nanny shall next after the making of this will be bound
off to serve and enjoy the same during her Natural life in
and of her third of my Negro woman Give unto my said son
Arthur my Negro woman Nanny and my Negro girl called
Mary the said to him and his heirs forever. And I Give
the third Child of my said Negro Nanny if it shall be a son he may
have title to my said land. And I Give to my said son
Arthur the first Child of my said Negro Sarah to my
daughter Anne Nafle and her heirs forever. And I Give to
my said son Henry Nafle the fourth Child of my said Negro
Nanny to him and his heirs forever. And my will is
before is that my said son Arthur Nafle when he shall be
of Age to enjoy my land as above. And I take my two said
sons and Henry to live and labour with him till they
Attain their respective Ages of one and twenty. And after
ward that he allow each of them a competency of money
with my said plantation with him. And I Give unto my said
William Charles a Red Liger not marked with all the female
Increase to be marked with a Z upon a left ear and an Under check or figure
And I Give my said first born Child to my said son Arthur Nafle
And I Give my said Plucky unto my said son Arthur Nafle
Cost of the said Plucky to fall to my said son Arthur Nafle to
raise for a Breeder for the benefit of him and his heirs forever.
And I Give all my appeared to him and his heirs forever.
