Order is granted to Mr. Thomas, Master of the Court, against the Estate of Mr. Jones in the County of Middlesex for four hundred pounds of the said County of Middlesex, to be paid to Mr. Jones, his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, upon the death of the said Mr. Jones, his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns. Esq. Master of the Court, 1st of July 1672 R.B.

Order is granted to Mr. Humphrey Jones against the Estate of Mr. Jones in the County of Middlesex for four hundred pounds of the said County of Middlesex, to be paid to Mr. Jones, his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, upon the death of the said Mr. Jones, his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns.

Order is granted to Thomas, Master of the Court, against the Estate of Mr. Jones in the County of Middlesex for four hundred pounds of the said County of Middlesex, to be paid to Mr. Jones, his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, upon the death of the said Mr. Jones, his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns.

Order is granted to Mr. Richard Robinson against the Estate of Mr. Jones in the County of Middlesex for eight hundred eight pounds of the said County of Middlesex, to be paid to Mr. Robinson, his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, upon the death of the said Mr. Jones, his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns.

Whereas Mr. Richard Robinson obtained Judgment at this Court the 2^d of March 1672, against Mr. Jones for the payment of two hundred and twenty pounds of the said County of Middlesex, with Costs, and Mr. Christopher Robinson Attorney to the said Mr. Robinson, now suing to have the said Judgment executed against the said Mr. Jones, his Estate. It is ordered that Mr. Christopher Robinson, Administrator to the said Mr. Jones, his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, do pay to Mr. Christopher Robinson, Attorney aforesaid, out of the said Estate of the said Mr. Jones, &c. the said sum of two hundred and twenty pounds of the said County of Middlesex, with all Costs of Suite, according to the priority of the said Debt, alias Debt. Esq. Master of the Court, 1st of July 1672 p. R.B.

Ordered that Mr. Rowland Mackroy, do deliver unto Hannah Lee, upon Oath all the Goods, which she hath in her possession, any ways belonging to her according to the will of her father, and to bring an account of the same to the next County Court. And it is desired by the said Hannah Lee that all her Cattle be delivered to Mr. Mackroy, and his receipt on this and on the next discharge. Rowland Mackroy.
